The Centre Track & Field Championships is a celebration of the 2025/2026 little athletics season. Centre Trophy Presentations, including age group awards, will be conducted on Wednesday 18 March 2026 from 5.30pm.

ELIGIBILITY The Centre Track & Field Championships are open to all Registered Athletes of Affiliated Clubs of Whittlesea City Little Athletics Centre ("WCLAC" or "Centre") ONLY, subject to the following:

- (a) Athletes **MUST** have completed a minimum of two (2) weeks of Centre weekly competition during the 2025-2026 season.
- (b) WCLAC has implemented a points system whereby each family is required to fulfil duties throughout the little athletics season for your child/children to be awarded with an end of season award and to compete at the Whittlesea City Little Athletics Centre Track and Field Championship Weekend. Please reach out to your Clubs to check if you have qualified.

ENTRY:

Each athlete may enter up to a maximum of four (4) events over both days. Athletes can only compete in events applicable to their age group (please refer to list of events in the table below)

PROGRAM:

COST:

Entry Fee is \$15.00 (plus processing fee) up to maximum of four (4) events.

UNIFORM:

Affiliated Club Uniform with Coles patch and Commonwealth Bank Registration Tag must be worn. Without the correct Uniform Athletes will not be able to compete.

AWARDS:

The first three (3) placegetters in each final event will receive a medal and a performance card and all other competitors will receive a “competed” ribbon and a performance card.

All track events will be timed finals.

The bar must be raised after each round of trials in increments depending on the number of athletes remaining in the competition, as per the following table

No of Athletes	Increment
Greater than 4	5cm
4 or Less	2cm
